



## Berlin Boat Club Chicken Wing Contest 2016



### **Four Judges for The Chicken Wing Contest as follows 2016:**

1. Denis Hoffman, he is working Chef, as in Green Lake Conference Center as a Pastry Chef. He was Class Instructor for Moraine Park Technical Institute, for some years. Worked as Executive Chef and Production Manager, at UW Oshkosh, for 6 years. Denis has been a working Chef since 1981. The Boss Chef.
2. Cathy Ransom: Currently working as Clinical Dietary Supervisor at the New Juliette Manor SNF and Rehab Center – Thedacare Berlin with more than 12 years of management experience in the CHN and now ThedaCare Family. After many ears of Cooking and Catering graduate from NWTC 2001 as a Certified Dietary Manger and Certified in Food Protection, we are very proud to have her aboard as a Judge. She is also member of Association of Nutrition & Food Services for 15 Years, and really a great person, just ask Her “Where are the Fish are biting” (avid outdoors person also).
3. Celebrity Judge Dennis Plantz Chief Of Berlin Police Dept., President State of Wisconsin Police Chief's and Former Wisconsin State Patrol Officer. The List goes on, A passion for Grilled meat and Chicken Wings. Proud to have him abroad as a Judge
4. Celebrity Judge Harry Kwidzinski, Former Chamber Director, Park and Recreation Boatd member, Veteran, He and his wife Voted Outstanding Berlin Citizen's of the Year. The List goes on, A passion for Grilled meat and Chicken Wings. And Harry is the Chicken Wing Contest on site coordinator. As Coordinator, any questions can be directed to Harry about the Contest. His Judgment is Final of the Group.

### **Judging:**

**New this year: Guest are invited to Judge the Teams, Tickets will be provided for them to Judge, each ticket should be signed on 1 side, and Team # on the other. The Scoring of those tickets will be used in case of Tie.**

1- 6 wings will be submitted to the Judges, in provided marked Styrofoam Box, for scoring in three Categories (1) Appearance (2) Tenderness/Texture (3) Taste. AT 1:15 SHARP.

2-Judging shall be done, by a team of 4 persons as a judging team, who are of at least 18 years of age. Only Judges, BBC Contest Reps and necessary support staff are allowed in Judging Tent or Trailer area, during the Judging process. No other activities are permitted in the Judging area, during judging process.

3- Each (Styrofoam) container in turn will be then be passed around the table, and each judge will place a sample wing from each of the numbered containers, in the appropriate area, or on the judging sheet.

4-The judge will then score each entry for (1) Appearance (red, bloody, undercooked meat) then wing itself on that Sample). (2) Judges then will sample the wing for texture and tenderness, (3) then a score will be given for taste. Before moving on to the next entry.

5-The scoring system is from 9 to 1 (all whole numbers) between one and nine may be used to score an entry. The scoring scale is: 9 excellent, 8 very good, 7 above average, 6 average, 5 below average, 4 poor, 3 bad, 2 too hot (Spicy). 1 not done (red, bloody, undercooked meat) pooled blood sauce or inadequate samples of meat

6-The tallying of the scorecards is as follows: People Choice score is used only in a tie.

**SCORING:** The low score, of one judge, will be thrown out. Results of the remaining 4 judge's scores for each contestant will be added together and an average score will be tallied. The winner will be declared. If there is a tie, (For one of Places 1, 2, or 3) it will be broken, as follows: The scores will be compared (counting all four judges) for the highest cumulative scores in taste +3, then tenderness +2, then appearance +1. After that and it still a tie, The low Score of one judge, being thrown out. If still tied, then the low score, which was thrown out, will be added back to the total and the highest score will break the tie. If still tied, then a coin toss will be used.

## **Contestant:**

NOTE: You Bring Your Own Grill, Charcoal or Wood. Gas Grill is OK but no Electric Grills.

- 1) Pick our best 6 Wings for the judging.
- 2) 6 wings will be placed in a Styrofoam Container (we Provide, and marked with Team # only). A BBC Rep will then Present to the Judges, for Scoring .
- 3) The other wings should be placed on a presentation platter You provide and should be available for guests to sample and vote (as samples are ready). At 1:15 PM Sharp Your Wings should be presented to the Judges). Starting at 12:30 PM, then 1 PM, the time will be announced as for remaining time. You should have your own Clock/Timer ... Turn In of your Samples are your responsibility.
- 4) The Judges will need your wings (with number assigned Team # on the Box), at 1:15 PM.
- 5) We will provide ample wings for the contest, all wings are divided equally.
- 6) We will provide, One Six Way Extension Cord, for the general site to be shared. You should bring your own extension Cord (no more than 25 ft, will be required) NO ROASTER OVEN, SLOW COOKERS and Large Current AC Appliance (electric hand mixer is fine). Also provided is a Marked off area measuring 20ft x 20 ft. for each team.
- 7) All cooking is done in that area.
- 8) We will provide Cold Tap Water (faucets in shelter house) for washing. NOTE: No Hot Water, for hand washing, or clean up will be provide.
- 9) The Berlin Boat Club will not be responsible for tents or other equipment left unattended before, during, or after the contest.
- 10) The Berlin Boat Club reserves the right to make additional regulations as the situations warrants. Decisions of the Berlin Boat Club Committee and Judges are FINAL
- 11) **If you have Samples of your wings and if they are available for the Event Guest (attendee's). A "Voting Ticket" for the Judging with be provided. We do ask for a donation to sample and vote.**

## **Winners:**

**1<sup>st</sup> Place: \$100 Cash, One Signature BBC Wall Plaque for 1<sup>st</sup> place, One Signed copy of “Sarah’s Home Cooked Meals made Easy” by Sarah Guenther of Cabin Cookery, and Judges will sign also most any thing if you want. Also be ready to explain your winning wings, a Short Story about your winning Wing’s.**

**2<sup>nd</sup> Place: \$50.00 Cash One Sarah Guenther of Cabin Cookery and Author of “Sarah’s Home Cooked Meals made Easy” One Copy Signed Copy**

**3<sup>rd</sup> Place: \$25.00 ... BBC Plaque, signing of Items and Sarah’s Home Cooked Meals Made Easy Book.**

**4<sup>th</sup> place or lower ... can ask about signing an Item, for being a Contestant, all are winners, every Team receives Limited Drink tickets (to be determined) and each cooking team member a Ticket for a free Roasted Cob of Corn.**

### **Contestant Rules:**

- 1) You must provide all Grills for cooking, Cooking utensils, Cups, Bowls, Towels, Paper Towels and Extension cords (50ft.) for Small Current Devices (no Roaster Pans, Crock Pots, Electric Fryer)
- 2) Smokers are Allowed, you must bring your own 100 ft. Extension Cords. to make it the Building outlets.
- 3) A Cooler with Ice for Raw Wing’s to keep wing below 40 degrees.
- 4) Clean Cloths and Hats Suitable for Cooking is your reasonability.
- 5) Keep it clean and picked up, people are watching you cook, it is a family event.
- 6) Please no accidents, only team member should be in your marked area, ask politely others to step outside of your marked line, or ask a BBC Member to help remove them.
- 7) Bring your own chair/tables/popup tent.
- 8) We ask no carry in (Like Beer or Soda, other than for cooking).
- 9) Leave the grounds Clean after Contest. Bring Your own Trash Bags
- 10) All cooking is done in that area.(not at Home)
- 11) We can only provide Cold Tap Water (faucets in shelter house) for washing. NOTE: No Hot Water, for hand washing, or clean up). So a small propane heater is fine to heat water.
- 12) We provide One Team Apron for team leader, Chef Cooking hats (one for each member cook, till gone)
- 13) Vehicles will NOT be allowed in the cooking areas after the contest starts 11PM. If items need to be loaded for departure, please bring wagons/handcarts to “load-out”.
- 14) Violations of rules and regulations of the contest will result in disqualification, expulsion, and/or disqualification from future participation in the event.
- 15) Read and keep these rules of the Berlin Boat Club Chicken Wing Cook-off
